



The Remote A/B switch is designed to switch one guitar between two amps. It is switched remotely, which will enable short audio cables to be used to the amps and improve signal quality. It is a passive relay circuit. If power unplugs or fails, the box will route to the A amp without causing loss of signal. The LED on the remote pedal is on when A is selected. Future version may use two-color LED.

A standard 1/4" cable of any length can be used for the remote switch.

Power Supply choices: Standard 9v or USB. If you already have a 9v adaptor running something nearby, use a DC splitter and power this from it. If you choose USB, any wall charger with a USB port can be used.

Options: Can be wired as "A or B" or "A + B" but not both. If both options are needed, extra components can be added at additional cost.

The Remote Selector can also be used in reverse to select two instruments to one amp without any modification.
